**SUBJECT:** Consider Update of LAFCo's 2015 Disadvantaged Unincorporated Communities Database.

**RECOMMENDATION:** Continue to a date uncertain.

**Background**

The Commission's adopted work plan for Fiscal Year 2019-20 included the scheduled update of LAFCo's 2015 Disadvantaged Unincorporated Communities (DUCs) Map Database. The DUC database is a tool that assists local agencies and LAFCo staff identify the locations of potential DUCs within Fresno County using Geographic Information Systems, County parcel information, and U.S. Census demographic files.

A comparison of the census datasets (American Communities Survey reports ("ACS") from years 2006 to 2010 compared to ACS reports for years 2012 to 2016) revealed that sufficient change (increase) in the Statewide Medium Household Income has occurred that may affect the status of previously identified DUCs in 2015 and through the Municipal Service Review Program.

Staff recommends the Commission to continue this item to a date uncertain to allow more time to assess the new Census datasets, and get a better idea of how the new Census datasets may update previous identified DUC locations.
